



Challenging Academics. Christian Community.






CHILL Renovation • \$50,000

Serving as a focal point for the new integrated learning model, the CHILL provides a setting designed to nurture student and faculty interaction, individual and collaborative study, and special programming. The facility offers a coffee shop atmosphere with tables, bookcases, and brightly covered couches and chairs.



In addition to restoration of a main room in the former estate house for the campus store, the Gallaher Center renovation project included new carpeting and furnishings for the building's lobby and admissions wing. The project has enhanced the first impressions made upon campus guests and prospective students.



Athletic Improvements • \$69,700

Offering additional opportunities for student participation, the college added junior varsity teams in men's baseball and women's basketball. During the summer, workers replaced the original 1963 gym floor with a layered wood and rubber surface that provides improved safety for student athletes.



Additional Student Scholarships • \$250,000

A 38% increase in the number of new students entering Rochester College this fall resulted in the need for additional scholarship funding. In a time of national economic stress, more students required scholarship assistance. Investment in the future of students pays eternal dividends.
