RU's ministry degrees are unique in that they train ministers for the church as it will be in a few years, not the church as it has been in the past.

We think about ministry less as a series of church-related tasks that must be accomplished and more as an ongoing process of learning to lead and listen in congregational discernment, in relationship to the ongoing mission of a living God.

All degrees have a mix of Bible, theology, history and ministry courses. We aim for education that focuses on the formation of the whole person and provide opportunities to connect outside the classroom in departmental chapels, retreats, game nights and bonfires. Students are also encouraged to serve RU's community by hosting worship services and other events.
