- The minutes of the July 16, 2001, meeting were approved.
- Scott led a discussion of the DALNET Board and Steering Committee visioning retreat. Results of this discussion are in a separate document
- DIA proposal for indexing the *DIA Bulletin* was rated among the top proposals submitted to date
- Teams for detailed interviews for the remaining top-ranked projects were established:
 - Michigan Supreme Court project: Muir and Libbey
 - Virtual Motor City project: Martin and Tubolino
 - HFM Postcards: Tubolino and Callaway
 - WSU Costume database: Walasky and Murphy
 - DIA Bulletin project: Walasky and Callaway
 - Study Club: Martin and Cromwell-Kessler
- Complete interviews by September 4, 2001
- D Callaway reported on the DALNET Newsletter; the first issues will announce the Health Calendar, and will contain an article on the IHDC. Tubolino will contact C Eames regarding remaining S3 issues, gaining access to files at DALNET, and reoccurring meeting capability of the software.

Im@gine

- Is IHDC supposed to focus on overall HUB or on digitization projects?
- DALNET members have to transition too, not just DALNET
 - All DALNET libraries have to move into the 'HUB' mentality
- Should members pay more (are they willing) to realize Im@gine?
- Should libraries publish? Is that part of their mission?
- We need to buy a (IOLS or other software) system for HUB that works and works now (infrastructure)

Horizon

- People can't do Horizon and day-to-day stuff & the HUB
- Should DALNET just be Horizon?
- Horizon has to be first, no staff or resources left for HUB
- IOLS vendors need to help us more, e.g. track electronic serials
- Our IOLS vendor bogs us down. We spend a lot of time trying to get them to do stuff and they will do it when they are ready.
- DALNET seems to be letting the *epixtech* contract drive us not our strategic needs, is that what we want to do?
 - DALNET enhancements
 - DALNET staff time
 - Time spent on Rider H
 - Keeping up with PCs to run Horizon infrastructure
 - We need to identify what is truly important and apply resource
 - Could Steering Committee evaluate what is truly important and what to let go?
 - What is mission critical for DALNET and for individual members?
 - Board or SC might do a Secret ballot

DALNET Communication and Infrastructure

- Need for better ways to manage Communication about issues and problems
- DALNET needs an intranet to meet its needs
- Message tracking
- Discussion and electronic conferences
- New efficient ways to provide training on modules etc
- Working groups need specific succinct charges-concrete
 - Group may need to 'adjust' if charge
- We need a Webmaster or at least access to web resources. What about at least mounting new website even if it is not complete.

Immediate Wins

- We need some examples of the HUB -some successes
- Something glitzy
- Good access to it - web
- We could do business FAQ now, Gateway to business (Dee has content)
- Health gateway can be the calendar and other health information that can be brought into the portal (gateway)
- Cultural resources
 - Cultural center list-links
- Add links to Horizon
 - Amazon.com
 - Etc
