Cost Allocation Reviews


The 2013 DALNET Cost Allocation Task Force has begun work on their review of the DALNET cost allocation formula. The committee has been charged with examining how costs are allocated, reviewing the minimum allocation for shared system members, pricing of services, considering new services for all members, and analyzing all costs for DALNET operations, among other things. The task force should have a final report to the Executive Committee by June this year. Also of note, the RIDES Delivery Task Force is reviewing what subsidies may be granted in support of resource sharing delivery for the next year and is expected to make recommendations by March.

DALNET Members Awarded NEH Grant

Congratulations to the libraries at Macomb Community College, Rochester College, and Wayne State University! They were among the 842 libraries across the country that will be awarded the Muslim Journeys Bookshelf, a collection of books, films, and other resources that will introduce the American public to the complex history and culture of Muslims in the United States and around the world.

Muslim Journeys Is presented by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) as part of its Bridging Cultures initiative, in cooperation with the American Library Association's (ALA) Public Programs Office.

New OCLC Policy Statement on RDA Released

A new policy about RDA records for WorldCat has been added as part of the RDA resources on the OCLC website. RDA (Resource Description and Access) is the new cataloging standard that will replace AACR2.
