DALNET Board Approves Upgrades for Horizon System

The DALNET Board has approved upgrade plans for Horizon/HIP. Upgrading to the newest version of the system will provide many new features, bug fixes, and support for newer computers. The Project Managers will discuss the upgrade at their February meeting and will be asked to convey project information back to their libraries. A committee of volunteers from DALNET member libraries will be formed to assist with preparing member institutions for anticipated changes in the way the HIP OPAC is configured and how it will operate. These changes will better situate the consortium to operate like most other shared systems. The upgrade is planned for this Spring/Summer. Look for lots more information coming in the following months.
