Executive Summary

Following is the 2004-05 Annual Degree/Certificate and Credit Hour Summary Report. Included in this report are rankings and counts of all associate degrees and certificates awarded, as well as the total number of credit hours generated by course prefix.

This report can be summarized with the following main points:

- The college granted 1,908 associate degrees and 160 certificates during the 2004-05 academic year. Degrees showed a 2.3% increase, and certificates awarded increased 5.6% ^{from} over the previous year.
- Four programs generated more than 100 degrees: Liberal Arts (575), Business Administration (243), General Studies (224) and Nursing (151).
- Certificates were most frequently awarded in Paralegal (17), Nursing - Modified Career Ladder (16), and Medical Assisting, Medical Insurance Coding & Billing (13).
- Over the course of the 2004-05 academic year, OCC provided 472,892 credit hours of coursework. This figure represents a slight increase of 0.9% in credit hours from the 2003-04 academic year.
- Fifteen course prefixes generated more than 10,000 credit hours:

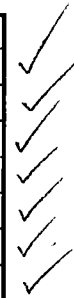
