General Education

(25 hours)

As a graduate of Macomb Community College, you may meet the general education requirement of Michigan Christian College with twenty-five hours of general education courses, including a minimum of one course each in written and oral communication, fine arts, literature, science, and history or another social science.

Specialization

(36-55 hours)

You receive a block of academic credit for the occupational courses you completed as a part of your associate degree program at Macomb Community College. This block of credit automatically becomes your specialization under the Bachelor of Business Administration degree at Michigan Christian College.

Business and Management

(24-46 hours)

Depending upon your degree from Macomb Community College, you complete from twentyfour to forty-six hours of business and management courses at Michigan Christian College.

Ethics and Christian Faith

(8 hours)

Two courses in ethics, *Introduction to Ethics* and *Ethics in Business*, and two courses in Biblical literature or religion provide a unique dimension to your Bachelor of Business Administration degree from Michigan Christian College.
