## THE RU ADVANTAGE

As you begin your studies at RU, you will start making connections between your past experiences and present opportunities for the purpose of discovering and shaping your identity. Throughout your academic journey, you will continually engage with the world around you and create a plan to use your experiences, knowledge and skills to discover and develop pathways to purpose and meaning. The story of God will be woven throughout your studies at RU, and you will continually reflect on how you can participate in God's mission in the world. As you approach graduation, you will apply your accumulated knowledge and experiences to a specific project and share the results with RU's academic community. The result of this work is well-educated and compassionate ministers who are able to serve communities of faith from the foundation of a God-centered identity.

**CHRISTIAN MINISTRY** A degree in Christian ministry prepares students for ministerial leadership. The combination of courses in the areas of biblical studies, theology, Christian history, ministry and spirituality provide a broad educational experience conducive to understanding and engaging the challenges of ministry life. This broad experience is also designed to help students discern their ministry calling. Opportunities are available for ministry experience, both within RU's campus ministry program and through a variety of internship possibilities.

**URBAN MINISTRY** A degree in urban ministry prepares graduates to participate in God's work of new creation within urban contexts, which are alternately places of energy, vibrancy, cultural expression, neglect, fragmentation and exploitation. The unique opportunities and challenges of urban ministry life require particular training that combines theology, sociology/social work, social entrepreneurship, psychology and ministry. RU provides direct experience through campus ministry opportunities and internships with partners in Detroit, Pontiac and Flint, Michigan.

**WORSHIP MINISTRY** Worship is a primary place where Christian belief and practice is formed. The worship ministry degree prepares students to serve God's people in the planning and leading of worship. Theology, ministry, music and theatre come together in this interdisciplinary degree to equip leaders for the broad demands of contemporary worship. Students in this program will gain hands-on experience through student worship ensembles (both full band and a cappella) and internships with area congregations.

**YOUTH AND FAMILY MINISTRY** The youth and family ministry degree prepares, students to aid families in spiritual formation. Students complete basic theology and ministry courses, as well as courses that orient them to the unique challenges related to adolescent spirituality in relation to contemporary culture. Additionally, youth and family ministry majors receive first-hand experience in the field, both within RU's campus ministry program and through internships.
